## **Repair & Renovation**

Repair & renovation of upgraded 155 BHUs & 17 RHC was one of the intervention of PHCIP. The repair and renovation of health facilities under the PHCIP project aimed to provide quality healthcare services to the community. Keeping in view the anticipated increased uptake of patients due to CCT & social mobilization, 400k were reserved/BHU & 1500k were reserved for each RHC. However, the allocated budget of 400k per BHU and 1500k per RHC was deemed insufficient due to inflation. As a result, the budget was revised to 1300k per BHU and 2500k per RHC.

In this regards a detailed policy and set of guidelines were prepared and disseminated. Health councils were actively involved As per guidelines priorities for repair and renovation works is as follows

- R&R of LHV residence to make it livable.
- R&R of necessary repair and renovation of labor room; paint (washable) on walls and roof over 6 feet height. Plumbing/ MEP works etc.
- R&R for addition of Hand Washing Station in Labor Room (Placement, Plumbing works etc.)
- Additional repair work in case of already existing ramp at entrance of Clinical Block of BHU Building.
- R&R of Flooring and wall paneling in MO room + LHV Room + Medical Technician/
  Dispenser Room and R&R attached washroom.
- R&R of existing ramp facilities (for PWDs and or patients, which may need wheelchair for their mobility) and repair & maintenance or construction of new ramp at entrance lobby of healthcare facility.
- R&R of internal Electrification with Lighting of Labor Room (including Washroom) and Entrance Lobby of RHC/BHU.
- Interior and exterior Paint work, Tiling in patient waiting area. Internal Electrification with Lighting of Labor Room (including Washroom) and Entrance Lobby of RHC/BHU.
- Repair/Replacement of Doors and Windows of Labor Room (including Washroom) and Entrance Lobby of RHC/BHU (if required or broken).

To undertake the repair and renovation works, a firm was hired to conduct a survey of all health facilities. The survey involved preparing a bill of quantity for the necessary repair and renovation works in a systematic manner. Survey of all health facility was undertaken, bill of quantity prepared and then necessary repair & renovation works were undertaken in a systematic manner. So far 163 million has been released out of which 111 million has been

spent while the rest is being actively utilized for repair and renovation activities. Details of funds is given in table given below:
